Job Description: **Swimming Teacher** 

**Department:** Sports Centre

**Reports to:** Centre Manager/ Assistant Manager/ Swim School Manager

**Job Purpose:** To be responsible for teaching swimming lessons and the staff and pupils involved in that lesson.

To Teach in accordance with job specification, all operational and safety guidelines.

## **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- 1. To provide safe and effective swimming lessons either in the swimming pool or on poolside.
- 2. To instruct assistant swimming teachers on how to provide support and assistance safely and accurately.
- 3. To provide a welcoming and pleasant class atmosphere to all pupils in lessons.
- 4. To interact with all children in your class in a friendly and positive manner.
- 5. To report any observations to the swim school manager regarding an individual's skill, ability or progression if required.
- 6. To maintain the high standards held within the swim school at all times.
- 7. To assist with swimming lesson administration when necessary during your shift.
- 8. To regularly assess all pupils in all your classes and discuss with the swim school manager as and when required to encourage pupils continued personal development.
- 9. To ensure assistant swimming teachers are aware of any medical conditions of pupils in your class and how to deal with if necessary.
- 10. To be responsible for the assistant swimming teachers in your classes at all times.
- 11. To report any concerns regarding classes, assistant teachers or any other swimming lesson issue to the swim school manager immediately
- 12. To be responsible for the safe keeping and storage of equipment during swimming lessons.
- 13. To be aware of Child Protection Policies & Reporting.
- 14. To wear uniform provided and be well presented at all times.
- 15. To be responsible for ensuring all your working hours are recorded correctly.
- 16. In the event of sickness and the inability to work inform a member of the sports centre staff as soon as possible.
- 17. To attend regular staff training and meetings on a frequency to ensure complete competence
